
## What Is Live Captioning?

Speech to Text


Chrome Browser + Google's Web Speech API

Text Captured Written as a Transcript to Your Browser

View Transcript as Plain Text or SRT Format



## Live Captioning is Not...

## CART

Communication

Access

Real-Time

Translation

Also Known as Open Captioning, Real-Time Stenography, and Real-Time Captioning

## Our goal is <u>not</u> to replace CART or Interpreters.

Instead, we are aiming to provide a reliable, no-cost tool to make events more accessible where there would otherwise be nothing.

## Live Captioning is For Everyone!

Timeout / Refresh

Text Extending Off Page

Browser Remembering Microphone Settings

However... Open Captioning is Not Perfect Either!
